INTRODUCTION

This policy describes how Cornerstone Alternatives collects, uses, and shares personal information when users visit our Website.

Cornerstone Alternatives refers to Cornerstone Alternatives LLC. Cornerstone Alternatives provides investment advisory and wealth services to individuals, families, and institutional clients, with a focus on private market investments, including private equity, private credit, real estate, venture capital, hedge funds, and other alternative investment strategies. Cornerstone Alternatives also provides access to alternative investment vehicles, including special purpose vehicles, co-investments, and fund allocations. Cornerstone Alternatives LLC is an SEC registered investment adviser. SEC registration does not imply any specific level of skill or training. Any visitor of the Website is a "User."

WEBSITE TERMS OF USE

The Website is owned and operated by Cornerstone Alternatives. By using the Website, Users accept and agree to be bound and abide by the terms hereof. Cornerstone Alternatives reserves the right to withdraw or amend the Website, and any service or material Cornerstone Alternatives provides on the Website in Cornerstone Alternatives' sole discretion without notice. Cornerstone Alternatives will not be liable if for any reason all or any part of the Website is unavailable at any time or for any period. From time to time, Cornerstone Alternatives may restrict access to some parts of or the entirety of the Website.

Any use of the Website not expressly permitted by the terms of this Policy is a breach thereof and may violate copyright, trademark, and other laws. Cornerstone Alternatives may remove a User's access to the Website at Cornerstone Alternatives' discretion.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

Users' privacy is important to Cornerstone Alternatives, and Cornerstone Alternatives wants to make their online experience satisfying and safe. Because Cornerstone Alternatives gathers certain information about Users, Cornerstone Alternatives feels that Users should understand the terms and conditions surrounding the capture and use of that information. Cornerstone Alternatives collects information directly from Users, such as when a User fills out a form on a Website, registers for an event, or signs up for electronic newsletters or alerts. Cornerstone Alternatives also collects data and information automatically when Users navigate through the Website, such as usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, web beacons, and other tracking technologies. Cornerstone Alternatives gathers information through aggregated tracking information derived mainly by tallying page views throughout our Website. This information allows us to better tailor our content to Users' needs and to help us better understand the demographics of our audience. By using the Website, Users consent to the collecting of information.

Cornerstone Alternatives may contract with third parties, such as LinkedIn, to collect data for consumers. For example, Cornerstone Alternatives may use lead gen forms on third-party websites where consumers may provide personally identifiable contact information, which are then provided to Cornerstone Alternatives.

If a User provides Cornerstone Alternatives with the User's contact information (including, without limitation, email address, phone number, mailing address, and/or contact information for social media and other communications platform), the User consents to Cornerstone Alternatives contacting them, including via text messaging. USAGE TRACKING

Cornerstone Alternatives tracks Users' traffic patterns throughout the Website, browsing activity, pages visited and the length of the visits, and other information related to Users' use of the Website. The information Cornerstone Alternatives collects automatically is only statistical data and does not include personal information, but Cornerstone Alternatives may maintain it or associate it with personal information that Cornerstone Alternatives collects in other ways or receives from third parties. This helps Cornerstone Alternatives to improve the Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling Cornerstone Alternatives to estimate audience size and usage patterns and to store information about Users' preferences, and by allowing Cornerstone Alternatives to customize the Website according to interest, speed up searches, and recognize when Users return to the Website.

Cornerstone Alternatives uses cookies and/or device identifiers to track Users' traffic patterns. In doing so, Cornerstone Alternatives may place a small text file in the browser files of Users' computers. The text file itself does not contain personal information, although it will enable Cornerstone Alternatives to relate a User's use of the Website to information that a User has

specifically provided. A cookie and/or device identifier cannot read data off Users' hard drive or files created by other sites. A User can refuse cookies by turning them off in their browser. If a User has set their browser to warn them before accepting cookies, they will receive the warning message with each cookie. Users do not need to have cookies turned on to use the Website, although refusing cookies may adversely impact the certain functionality of the Website.

In addition, pages of the Website may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit Cornerstone Alternatives, for example, to count Users who have visited those pages and for other related website statistics. Cornerstone Alternatives creates aggregated reports on User demographics and traffic patterns, allowing Cornerstone Alternatives to advertise more effectively.

The Website uses Google Analytics (or a similar third-party service) to collect data about the demographics of the people who access the Website. If Users do not want their information collected, they may opt out of our vendor's use of cookies and/or device identifiers by visiting Google's Ads Settings. Alternatively, Users can control the use of such cookies and/or device identifiers through their browser settings.

Cornerstone Alternatives also may use automatic data collection technologies to collect and aggregate information about Users' online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking). Users may set their browsers to opt-out from online behavioral tracking by enabling Do Not Track. Cornerstone Alternatives may contract with third-party vendors, including Google, to show Cornerstone Alternatives ads on various third-party websites. Cornerstone Alternatives and its third-party vendors serve ads based on a User's visit to the Website.

Cornerstone Alternatives uses the above-described information to tailor the Website's content, to help Cornerstone Alternatives better understand usage and Users' demographics, and to allow Cornerstone Alternatives to advertise more efficiently.
